Sample Itinerary

Day One

10.00am: Meet at 'Birds of Prey Displays', Thirsk. Discuss the workshop over coffee; time for any questions and queries
10.30am: Bird of Prey Photography; photographing 3 or 4 species including one to be flown
2.00pm: Lunch
3.00pm: Check into hotel; allow time to settle in and more discussion in lounge area
4.00pm: Nidderdale; photographing upland birds – Grouse, Lapwing, Oystercatcher
8.00pm: Evening meal at hotel or local Pub
9.30pm: Time for drinks and to discuss the day's photography

Day Two

06.00am: Breakfast
07.30am: Photograph Peregrine Falcons at Malham Cove; possible wheatear, buzzard, kestrel
11.00pm: Lunch
12.00pm: Gordale Beck photographing Dipper, Grey Wagtail, Pied Wagtail; possible Redstart, Pied Flycatcher, Spotted Flycatcher, Swallow, House Martin
4.00pm: Return to hotel – post processing images/workshop session. Relaxation time
7.30pm: Evening meal
9.00pm: Relaxing in bar lounge

Day Three

05.30am: Grinton Moor; photographing Red Grouse, Curlew, Lapwing, Golden Plover, Meadow Pipit; possible Short Eared Owl
9.00am: Breakfast
12.00pm: Return to hotel for check out; Lunch
2.00pm: Studley Royal; photographing red, fallow and sika deer (option to take own car if on route home)
6.00pm: Finish and discuss workshop before heading home.

Please note: this is a *sample* itinerary and subject to change. All locations will be visited but each day will be judged on the best location to fit the prevailing weather conditions. Paul Miguel cannot guarantee specific wildlife species to be present, however all wildlife sites have been carefully chosen by Paul using his knowledge of each location and its wildlife based on years of experience.
